CONFERENCE ABSTRACT

The conference abstract should be between 150 and 250 words including the author's name, affiliation, e-mail address of the corresponding author, and a maximum of 6 keywords written in MS Word document.

GUIDELINES FOR FULL PAPER SUBMISSION

- Paper should be written in MS Word, 12-point font size, double line spacing, Times New Roman font type, and should be between 10 to 12 pages including references.
- The cover page should include the paper title, the author's name, affiliation, and e-mail address, followed by the abstract of the study of not more than 150 words.

- A minimum of five alphabetically organized keywords should be included in the abstract of the article, which should be between 150 and 250 words long.
- Papers must be original and written in clear and coherent sentences.
- Tables, figures, graphs, and diagrams if any, should be embedded in the main body of the work where they appear using the appropriate format.
- American Psychological Association (APA) 7th edition referencing style.

MODE OF PRESENTATION

The conference is purely virtual and registered participants will receive login information and links for presenting. The presentation will take 15 minutes with an additional 5 minutes for questions and answers.
